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- 1 · Paper submitted should be by e-mail attachment or on a virus-free CD in the MS-Word format, accompanied by one hard copy showing printing styles such as boldface, italics and tables (if any). The CD should be labeled with the name of author and the kind of software used.
 - 2 · The author's name, position, affiliation, address, E-mail address, contact number(s) of telephone, and Fax, should be given in both English and Chinese. Please also enclose 3 self-addressed envelopes with enough stamps.
 - 3 · Paper should be around 5000 words in length and should include an abstract (no more than 300 words), keywords (3 or less). A Chinese version of the abstract and keywords together with a Chinese title should also be included. For empirical research papers, the abstract should describe the background, goals, research method and results in the abstract. For conceptual papers, the abstract should describe the background, discussion focus and suggestions.
 - 4 · Submissions should be presented in APA style. Please consult The Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association.
 - 5 · All tables and illustrations should be camera-ready.
 - 6 · Papers previously published or under consideration for publication elsewhere will not be accepted.
 - 7 · All submissions will be double blind reviewed. Authors should include not more than two of their own publications in the references during the initial reviewing stage to ensure the anonymous status.
 - 8 · After the review, contributors will be contacted for revision. The editors reserve the right for refinement.
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 - 10 · The views expressed in the publication are those of the authors and do not necessarily reflect the position of the Journal.
