A Summer Research Conference and Workshops  
**July 30-August 4, 2011**

**U**niversity Professors, school teachers (PreK-12) and education policy makers are cordially invited to participate in a five-day summer Global Institute organized by Ohio Department of Education and Ohio University, at Athens, Ohio, USA.

As emerging technologies and globalization have had profound impact on all aspects of education from preschool to college, we will gather explore answers for questions such as: How should educational systems keep up with all the changes in the world? How can we reform school systems to meet the needs of the changing world and digital learner? Participants from around the world will present their research, conduct symposium, and participate in hands-on workshops, discussions and school visits in USA.

### SUBMISSION STRANDS AND GUIDLINES:

Papers in the following areas of research (qualitative, quantitative and action research) in education are sought for presentation:

- Technology integration for teaching and learning
- School reform for global learning
- Mobile learning
- Valuing the online school and institution
- Web 2.0 and the classroom
- Digital natives and the changing boundaries of learning
- The new role of the administrator in global learning environments
- 21st Century Learners
- Global learning and its impact on higher education and K-12

**Submit papers to** Dr. Teresa Franklin at [franklit@ohio.edu](mailto:franklit@ohio.edu) by February 15, 2011, with confirmation of paper acceptance by March 1, 2011. In the email subject lines place the words: "Going Global". Each paper presentation will be 25 minutes in length.

A laptop, projector and internet access will be provided for each presenter's use at the conference.

The paper submission is to be 5 to 8 single-spaced pages (no more or less), including references, in Times Roman 11 point font using APA 5th Edition or 6th Edition style for citations and references. Doctoral Level Graduate Students are also invited to submit papers.
